PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Vice President Librizzi stated that in August 2025 Berkeley Township attorney submitted a lease agreement to our Board in hopes of leasing our Annex due to the discontinuation of Volunteer First Aid 44 Services. The Board of Trustees had our legal services review the lease, which was sent back to the township administrator for execution on August 15th, 2025. Unfortunately although Berkeley Township obtained all the necessary paperwork, the transfer of utility services was never finalized. Despite multiple calls and communication, operational costs continued to be covered by Westerly homeowners. With no advancement regarding the vacant space and growing demand for clubhouse storage, the BOT have decided to rescind the verbal agreement. A vote count was taken with the following results. 8 Yes, unanimously. All in favor. Motion Henny Second Karen Kathy Hopkins also read Resolution - 2025 Resolution of Silver Ridge Park Westerly Homeowners Association Regarding Partial Payments made to Association Due From Owners. (see full Resolution in Office) 8 yes all in favor unanimously. Motion Kathy Second Joe

A motion was made to accept contract NJNG Save Green estimate for 2 Boiler replacements, all interior Clubhouse Lighting Upgrade, Low flow Water faucet and Wi-Fi control thermostats for Westerly Clubhouse; The initial Project cost is \$80,882.73 and incentive is \$50,372. Cost to us is \$30,510.23 in one lump sum or 59 monthly payments of \$508.14. A vote was taken with results 8 yes. All in favor. Motion Henny Second Jeanine.

A resolution was made to change the date of the Annual Election of Trustees outlined in Article 11A Section 8 Nomination and Election of Trustees to replace the 2nd Tuesday of June to the 3rd. Tuesday of June. This adjustment aligns with the Election Timeline recommended by RADBURN.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Kathy Hopkins stated December's meeting was opened with wishing all members a wonderful holiday season and a very Happy New Year. A motion was taken to accept the December 2025 minutes. 1st –Karen, 2nd – Joe. All in favor unanimously - minutes approved. Holiday part 2025 began.

THE TREASURERS REPORT

Betty O'Brien read the report. The treasurer's report is posted in the Signpost and on our website. A motion to accept the report, 1st – Kathy Hopkins, 2nd – Diana Dillon All in favor unanimously - Financial Report approved. See official report in the Signpost.

Henny Warmenhoven stated nothing to report.

COMMON GROUND

Henny Warmenhoven reminded everyone once again. that, you or your lawn services are NOT to place leaves, branches, garbage or any debris in the COMMON AREA. No problem with trees due to the recent storm.

Henny stated that Smitty will clean up branches and pine needles that apparently some contractors may have left on the street. He is asking that anyone that notices dumping of branches or debris to please call him immediately.





OCEAN COUNTY PRESS RELEASE

1/29/2026 - OCEAN COUNTY READY TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO SENIORS IN 2026

From telephone reassurance services to assistance in paying for household utilities, the Ocean County Board of Commissioners approved 24 contracts to provide services for the County's growing senior population during its Jan. 21 Board meeting.

"Ocean County is committed to making sure our seniors are supported, respected, and able to age with dignity," said Ocean County Commissioner Robert Arace, who serves as liaison to the Ocean County Office of Senior Services. "These contracts reflect our responsibility to meet people where they are and ensure that essential services are available to older adults across every corner of the county."

The 24 Area Plan contracts provide more than \$8 million in funding for 51 programs designed to serve older adults and their caregivers throughout Ocean County. Collectively, the contracts are expected to deliver more than 560,000 units of service to over 30,000 older adults and caregivers countywide.

Services funded through the contracts are projected to include approximately 92,000 home-delivered meals, more than 21,000 transportation rides, and over 2,000 hours of home repair services, all aimed at helping older adults remain safe and independent in their homes.

"With more than \$8 million invested through these Area Plan contracts, we are delivering real, measurable help; from meals and transportation to home repairs and caregiver support," said Arace.

Additional services funded through the contracts include social support programs; congregate and home-delivered meal services, including weekend and holiday meals; caregiver support services through the National Family Caregiver Support Program; adult protective services; transportation assistance; residential maintenance and home repair services; legal assistance; safe housing and transportation programs; and evidence-based health promotion and chronic disease management programs. The contracts also expand telephone reassurance services and evidence-based programs focused on wellness, physical health, and overall quality of life.

"These programs are about independence, health, and quality of life," said Arace. "Whether it's a wellness check, a hot meal, transportation to an appointment, or help maintaining a safe home, Ocean County is focused on giving our seniors the resources they need to remain active, connected, and secure in their communities."

The contracts are part of Ocean County's ongoing efforts to support its growing senior population and help older adults safely age in place.

Preventing Slips, Trips & Falls

KNOW THE RISKS

Slips and trips are two of the most frequent causes of injury in the workplace and cost employers millions every year. However, the majority of accidents caused by slips and trips can be easily avoided by following a few simple guidelines.

By following the principles set out in this poster, you can ensure that your workplace is free from slip and trip hazards and that accidents are kept to a minimum.



1. HAZARD - SPILLAGES

Spillages

Clean spills up at once. Remember that the cleaning agent needed will depend on the nature of the spill. If the floor remains wet after the spill has been cleaned, make sure people are aware of this by using appropriate signs. Arrange a diverted route that avoids the area if necessary.



2. HAZARD - CABLES

Cables

Try to make sure that cables do not cross walkways. Use cable curbs and tunnels to prevent trips if necessary.



3. HAZARD - OBSTRUCTIONS

Obstructions


Permanent obstructions and any objects left lying around can easily create a trip hazard if they are not seen. Keep work areas clear of obstructions. If this is not possible, use appropriate signs or barriers to make people aware of hazards.



4. HAZARD - FLOORING

Flooring


Look for any cracks, holes or uneven wear etc that may cause a trip hazard. If the floor regularly becomes wet or slippery through working procedures, consider how this can be contained or prevented.



5. HAZARD - FOOTWEAR

Footwear


Choice of footwear can be crucial in preventing slips and trips. If special footwear is needed to ensure the safety of employees, the employer must provide it.



6. HAZARD - LIGHTING

Lighting

Lighting should be adequate enough to enable people to see obstructions and hazards. Ensure that faulty lights are replaced and dirty lights are cleaned before levels become too low for people to work in safety.



7. PREVENTING ACCIDENTS

An effective management system will enable you to:

- Ascertain any slip and trip problems.
- Identify the best course of action.
- Execute your chosen course of action.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of your precautions.

You should try to incorporate the following steps into your system.

1. Ask which areas of your workplace contain slip and trip hazards and devise a strategy for improvement. Minimise slip and trip hazards through effective equipment and working procedures.
2. Make sure workers are aware of slip and trip risks and are committed to minimising them. Give people safety responsibilities. Ensure a record is kept of who is responsible for what.
3. Carry out regular checks to ensure that any safety procedures are being carried out properly. Keep a record of cleaning and maintenance work.
4. Review the approach to slip and trip issues on a regular basis and examine accident reports.





In keeping with Berkeley Township shed ordinance, homeowners are permitted, effective immediately, to install one (1) shed on their property, up to and including 64 square feet.
(8' x 8' x 8')

Modification of existing shed policy 11th in the architectural Rules and Regulations was voted for, approved and has changed to:

1. Sheds may not be placed anywhere other than the rear of the home.
2. All sheds must remain within the sidelines of the home.
3. Sheds may NOT be installed on common ground property.
4. Said shed shall be of any structure material the homeowner desires.
5. Sheds that are required to be fastened must be on a firm ground structure. DO NOT place any shed on a cement slab. Cement slabs add square feet to your taxable living space and will be taxed by Berkeley Township.
6. In accordance with Berkeley Township ordinance, sheds must be placed at least three feet from the back of the property line.
7. Although Berkeley Township requires only a 3 foot side setback, SRP Westerly requires all shed placement to remain within the sidelines of the home.
8. In accordance with Berkeley Township ordinance, electrical wiring of sheds is not permitted.
9. If a homeowner chooses to install a shed against their home, it may not block any windows or doors.
10. Homeowners MUST submit an architectural approval request form along with a drawing showing the location of the proposed shed to the SR Westerly Architectural Committee. *(Architectural forms are available in your monthly copy of the Sign Post).*
11. The homeowner must submit a zoning permit application, required fees and forms to the Berkeley Township Town Hall /Zoning Office. *(Zoning Permit Application forms can be obtained from the Berkeley Township website or the Zoning Office.)*
